

Change Desktop from LXDE to XFCE

Steps

```
1. $ sudo apt update
```

```
2. $ sudo apt install task-xfce-desktop
```

3. Log out of the current session or restart the system

4. From the login screen, click the gear icon, select the desired desktop environment and log in to your user account as usual

5. Remove LXDE with

```
$ sudo tasksel purge lxde-desktop
```

6. Remove LXDE packages

```
apt-get purge PCManFM  
apt-get purge lxterminal  
apt-get purge lxtask  
apt-get purge lxpulse  
apt-get purge lxrandr  
apt-get purge lxde*  
apt autoremove
```
