Configuration

Static IP address

/etc/network/interfaces

```
# The primary network interface
auto eth0
iface eth0 inet static
    address 192.168.1.11
    netmask 255.255.255.0
    network 192.168.1.0
    gateway 192.168.1.1
```

Don't forget to disable the DHCP server in the router!

```
sudo /etc/init.d/networking restart
```

Access rights

To remove the password for the main admin when entering superuser mode, do the following:

```
visudo
add line: <username> ALL=(ALL) NOPASSWD: ALL
```

Re-install Ubuntu

Before starting the new install, do the following:

- make a copy of /etc and /home/username
- install ubuntu
- copy /etc/lvm from backup
- lvm> vgcfgrestore vg
- copy /etc/fstab from backup

If you want to start with fresh settings for your username, additionally do the following:

- mount /home which resides on a lv to a different mount-point (e.g. /backup) and rename your
 previous /home/username
- copy /home/username to /backup
- umount /backup and mount /home, /srv, /backup (my lv created during the previous installation)

Finally, you need to change the ownership of your previous username:

chown -R username:users /home/username

For Ubuntu Hardy Heron 8.04 only

Remove NetworkManager

apt-get remove network-manager network-manager-gnome

Maintain NIC names

Changing network cards or the motherboard requires to update the MAC adresses:

vim /etc/udev/rules.d/70-persistent-net-rules
