

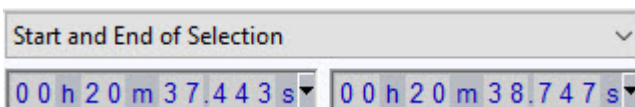

Repair

Stereo channel left or right

Some records might have damages in one stereo channel only. If those damages are difficult to repair you might consider to simply copy the undamaged channel over the damaged channel. You'll lose the stereo effect in the process, but the result might still sound better than trying to deal with the damage and modify or destroy the music in the damaged channel, special when the damaged area is not very long.

1. Open the track menu (triangle arrow on the left side of the track, or SHIFT-M on a selected track) and select *Split Stereo Track*
2. Identify the start and end position of the damage, then select the same position in the undamaged track (shows as white background after selection), then hit CTRL-C to copy into the clipboard
3. Take a note of the selected area at the bottom of the Audacity window



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
