

# piCorePlayer 9.0.1

A SqueezeLite player on the Raspberry Pi

## Install

1. Download [piCorePlayer](#) v9.0.1 32 Bit which will work on a Raspberry Pi v1
2. Burn the image to a SD card, 4GB is more than sufficient
3. The built in audio output will work out of the box
4. To use a [DragonFly](#) USB audio device, go to the web interface of your Pi:
  1. Open the settings page by navigating to the player's IP address in your browser
  2. In Squeezelite Settings set Audio output device settings to *USB audio* and save
  3. In Change Squeezelite settings set Output setting to *hw:CARD=DragonFly,DEV=0*
