

# GIMP 2.8

## Change color of text within selection

- Select layer with color area to be changed, then select this color area with the *Fuzzy Select Tool*.
- Select layer with text and click text within color area, this should result in selection around text within color area. If the selection is outside, you need to *invert* the selection of the color area first.
- Click *Select* -> *Selection Editor*, set *Opacity* to 100, *Threshold* to 80, *Fill by* to Alpha, and enable *Antialiasing*.
- Select *Bucket Fill Tool*, choose foreground color, and click on each letter within the color area.
