## Set time

Get time from Ubuntu's time server:

```
ntpdate ntp.ubuntu.com
```

Select time zone:

```
tzselect
```

Use the following commands to read the hardware clock, read the hardware clock localtime, update it, update it to localtime, update the system clock from the hardware clock:

```
/sbin/hwclock  
/sbin/hwclock --localtime  
/sbin/hwclock --systohc  
/sbin/hwclock --systohc --localtime  
/sbin/hwclock --hctosys  
/sbin/hwclock --hctosys --localtime
```
